

## How to Use Scotch® Removable Double-Sided Tape for Cardmaking

### Antique Linen



This design incorporates both the envelope and card into one. Double-sided scrapbooking paper is accented with two different textures of ribbon, a shell button. **Scotch® Removable Double-Sided Tape** is used to attach the stationary to the inside of the card which allows for easy repositioning without damaging the paper.



Difficulty – Medium

### Materials

- 12 x 12 double-sided antique green fabric patterned scrapbooking paper with solid color on back
- 2-inch wide green mesh ribbon
- 1/2-inch wide green satin ribbon
- 1 green iridescent shell button
- 1 sheet cream colored stationary paper
- **Scotch® Removable Double-Sided Tape** (for attaching stationary paper)
- **Scotch® 6-inch Precision Scissors** (for cutting paper and ribbon)
- **Scotch® Clear Glue with 2-Way Applicator** (for gluing ribbon)
- **Scotch® Reclosable Fasteners** (for sealing card)

### Instructions

1. Using **Scotch® 6-inch Precision Scissors**, cut the piece of scrapbooking paper in half so it measures 6 x12 inches.



2. On the wrong side of the paper, measure 2 inches from the top of each side and draw a line from each mark to the center top.
3. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors**, cut off the corners to form an envelope point.



4. From the bottom edge of the paper, fold up 5-3/4 inches and crease the edge.
5. Fold the top 2-1/2 inches down to create the envelope overlap.



6. Cut a piece of the green mesh ribbon the entire length of the scrapbooking paper.
7. Using the precision tip of **Scotch® Clear Glue**, attach the ribbon to the center front of the scrapbooking paper, trimming the edges around the point. Small amounts of glue can be added to the cut edges of each end of the ribbon to prevent fraying.

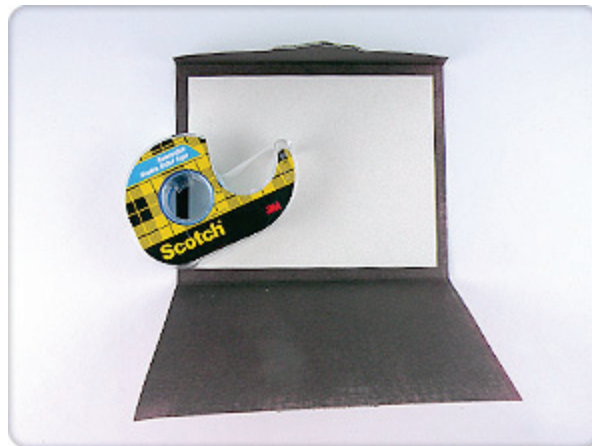


8. Cut two pieces of the green satin ribbon the length of each side of the flap.
9. Using the precision tip of **Scotch® Clear Glue**, attach the ribbon to each side of the flap, trimming off any excess. Small amounts of glue can be added to the cut edges of each end of the ribbon to prevent fraying.



10. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of the stationary paper one inch smaller than the length and width of the inside top of the card.
11. Using **Scotch® Removable Double-Sided Tape**, apply strips of tape to the wrong side of the top, bottom and sides of the stationary paper.
12. Attach the piece of stationary to the inside top of the card, centering it evenly between the sides, top and bottom fold.

**Note:** The removable double-sided tape allows for easy repositioning without damaging the paper.



13. Feed a string or thread through the button holes and tie on the back of the button to make it look sewn on.
14. Using **Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue**, apply glue to the back of the button and attach it to the center of the flap about an inch above the point. Let dry.



15. Cut a small piece of **Scotch® Reclosable Fasteners** and attach one side to the inside point of the flap and the other to the card making sure they line up evenly.



16. Cut a 1-1/5 inch x 1 inch piece of patterned scrapbooking paper and attach it with **Scotch® Clear Glue** to the center of the inside bottom of the card.
17. Cut four pieces of the green satin ribbon the length of each side of the piece of scrapbooking paper. Cut each end at angle so they meet up to form a corner as shown below.
18. Using the precision tip of **Scotch® Clear Glue**, attach the ribbon to each side piece of scrapbooking paper, slightly overlapping the paper.
