

## How to Use Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Precision Scissors for Crafts

# Designer Pinboard



This pinboard is layered with cork, batting and fabric all cut with **Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Precision Scissors**. The combination of the cork and ribbon makes this board versatile so it can be used with or without pins. The fabric and ribbon can be changed to suit the décor of any room.



Difficulty – Hard

### Materials

- 15 x 20 inch piece of foam board
- A roll of cork
- Quilters batting
- Fabric of your choice
- 1/8 inch-wide satin ribbon in two colors to match the fabric color
- Pins with round head to match the fabric color
- 6 decorative brads, backing removed
- 6 small rhinestones to match the brad color
- **Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Precision Scissors** (for cutting ribbon)
- **Scotch® Double-Stick Tape** (for securing folded fabric)
- **Scotch® Magic Tape** (for securing ribbon)
- **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** (for ribbon and brads)
- **3M™ Super 77 Spray Adhesive** (for attaching cork and batting)
- **Scotch® Mounting Tape** (for mounting the finished board to the wall)

### Instructions

1. Using **Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Precision Scissors**, cut a 15 x 20 inch piece of cork to match to size of the foam board.



2. Spray a thin coat of **3M™ Super 77 Spray Adhesive** to the foam board and attach the cork, lining up the edges.



3. Using the **Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Precision Scissors**, cut four 15 x 20 inch pieces of quilters batting to match to size of the foam board.
4. Spray a thin coat of **3M™ Super 77 Spray Adhesive** to the cork and attach a layer of batting, lining up the edges. Continue to spray the batting with adhesive spray until all four layers are attached.
5. Trim the edges if necessary if they extend beyond the foam board.



6. Cut a piece of fabric measuring 19 x 24 inches using **Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Precision Scissors**.
7. Spray the batting with adhesive spray and place the batting side of the board down centered on the wrong side of the fabric. Smooth out the creases and folds in the fabric.





8. Attach strips of **Scotch® Double-Stick Tape** around the edges of the back of the board and fold each corner of the fabric up over the foam board corners.



9. Fold up each side of the fabric and secure it to the double-stick tape strip.



10. Using **Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Precision Scissors**, cut two pieces of ribbon measuring 31 inches and the four pieces of the alternate color ribbon measuring 18 inches.
11. Apply **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** to one of the back corners of the board and attach the end of 31 inch piece of ribbon. Place a piece of **Scotch® Magic Tape** over the ribbon to secure it while the glue is drying. The tape does not have to be removed once the glue is dry.
12. Stretch the ribbon around the right side of the board to the other corner and attach with glue and tape. Make sure the ribbon is pulled tight enough so there is no slack. Repeat this process on the other corners of the board.
13. Measure the center point of the four sides of the board. Attach the four 18 inch pieces of ribbon with glue and tape on the back of the board at each center point making sure they cross on the fabric side.



14. Insert a pin on the board on each place where the ribbon crosses each other on the front. Clip off the sharp point and bend the pin down on the back so it is flat with the board.



15. Place a piece of **Scotch® Magic Tape** over the bent down pin ends to hold them in place and cover the exposed metal.
16. Using **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive**, attach strips of ribbon over the raw edge of the fabric to give the back of the board a finished look.



17. Apply a generous amount of **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** to the top of each pin head and attach a decorative brad. Glue a rhinestone to the center of each of the brads.
18. Use **Scotch® Mounting Tape** to attach the board to the wall.
