

# Black Widow



## Black Widow

Spiderweb patterned scrapbooking paper is accented with black ribbon and plastic spiders to create this Halloween design. A gift bag, a takeout box and a small treat bag for kids make this set ideal for any type of Halloween celebration.



## Takeout Box

Difficulty – Medium



### Materials


- Medium black takeout box (takeout boxes are inexpensive and easy to find at your local craft or party store)
- Spiderweb patterned craft or scrapbooking paper
- 1/8-inch wide black satin ribbon
- 1 small black plastic spider
- 1 small round red rhinestone
- Scotch® Precision Scissors (6" for cutting ribbon and 8" for cutting craft paper)
- Scotch® Permanent Glue Stick (for attaching craft paper)
- Scotch® Clear Glue with 2-Way Applicator (for gluing ribbon)
- Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue (for gluing the spiders)

### Instructions

1. Attach the red rhinestone onto the back of the small spider using Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue.



2. To cover the handle, apply a small amount of Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue to the end of the back of the ribbon and attach it to the box where the metal handle meets with the side of the box. Let dry.
3. Wrap the ribbon tightly around the handle, slightly overlapping as you go.
4. Finish by cutting the ribbon and applying a small amount of glue to the end of the back of the ribbon and attach it to the box where the metal handle meets with the side of the box.



5. Cut a piece of the spiderweb patterned craft paper the entire size of the front of the box. You can use the box to trace the shape. Try to account for the pattern before you cut the paper so there will be a whole spiderweb design on the front of the box.
6. Using the Scotch® Permanent Glue Stick, apply glue to the wrong side of the craft paper, especially around the edges. Attach the spiderweb craft paper to the front of the box, lining up the edges of the paper with the edges of the box.



7. Cut two pieces of the black satin ribbon the entire width the front of the top part of the box. Using the precision tip of Scotch® Clear Glue, attach one piece of ribbon to the front of the box 1/2 inch from the top and the other 1/4 inch below the first. Small amounts of glue can be added to the cut edges of each side of the ribbon to prevent fraying.
8. Cut two more pieces of the black satin ribbon the entire width the front of the bottom part of the box. Using the precision tip of Scotch® Clear Glue, attach one piece of ribbon to the front of the box 1/2 inch from the bottom and the other 1/4 inch above the first. Small amounts of glue can be added to the cut edges of each side of the ribbon to prevent fraying.



9. Using the Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue, attach the small spider onto the center of the spiderweb placing it at a slight angle.



## Gift Bag



Difficulty – Medium

### Materials

- Medium black gift bag with stiff handles (plain gift bags are inexpensive and easy to find at your local craft or party store)
- Spiderweb patterned craft or scrapbooking paper
- Black matte craft or scrapbooking paper
- 1-inch wide black satin ribbon
- 1 large plastic spider and 2 small plastic spiders
- 4 small red rhinestones
- Scotch® Precision Scissors (6" for cutting ribbon and 8" for cutting craft paper)
- Scotch® Permanent Glue Stick (for attaching craft paper)
- Scotch® Clear Glue with 2-Way Applicator (for gluing ribbon)
- Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue (for gluing the spiders)
- Decorative black tissue paper

### Instructions

1. Attach one red rhinestone onto the back of each small spider and two rhinestones onto the back of the large spider using Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue.




2. Cut a piece of the spiderweb patterned craft paper 1/2 the length and the full width of the front of the gift bag.
3. Using the Scotch® Permanent Glue Stick, apply glue to the wrong side of the craft paper especially around the edges. Attach the paper to the front of the gift bag, centering the paper evenly on the front of the bag.
4. Cut two pieces of the black craft paper each 1/4 the length and the full width of the front of the gift bag.
5. Using the Scotch® Permanent Glue Stick, apply glue to the wrong side of the craft paper especially around the edges. Attach the paper to the front of the gift bag, lining up the edge of the one piece of the black craft paper with the top edge of the bag and the other with the bottom edge of bag and so each piece meets the spiderweb craft paper.



6. Cut two pieces of the black satin ribbon the entire width of the front of the gift bag.
7. Using the precision tip of Scotch® Clear Glue, attach each ribbon to the front of the gift bag so they are centered over each edge of the spiderweb craft paper. Small amounts of glue can be added to the cut edges of each side of the ribbon to prevent fraying.



8. To cover the handles, apply a small amount of Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue to a few inches of the back of the ribbon and wrap the ribbon around the handle where it meets with the inside of the bag.
9. Continue to add small amounts of glue to the ribbon, a few inches at a time, as you continue to wrap the ribbon around the handle, slightly overlapping the ribbon.
10. Finish by cutting the ribbon and gluing the end behind the handle where it meets with the inside of the bag. Repeat this process with the other handle.



11. Using the Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue, attach the two small spiders onto the each side of the spiderweb placing them at a slight angle. Glue the large spider directly on top of the ribbon closest to the top of the bag, centering it under the handles.



12. Fill the bag with layered tissue paper to finish.



## Treat Bag

Difficulty – Easy



### Materials


- Small black treat bag
- Spiderweb patterned craft or scrapbooking paper
- Black matte craft or scrapbooking paper
- 1-inch wide black satin ribbon
- 1 large black plastic spider
- 2 small red rhinestones
- Stick-on silver letters for child's name
- Scotch® Double Sided Tape (for closing the bag)
- Scotch® Precision Scissors (6" for cutting ribbon and 8" for cutting craft paper)
- Scotch® Permanent Glue Stick (for attaching craft paper)
- Scotch® Clear Glue with 2-Way Applicator (for gluing ribbon)
- Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue (for gluing the spider)

### Instructions


1. Fold the top of the treat bag over to the back 1-1/2 inches from the top.
2. Attach two rhinestones onto the back of the large spider using Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue.




3. Cut a piece of the spiderweb patterned craft paper  $\frac{3}{4}$  the length and the entire width of the front of the bag.
4. Using the Scotch® Permanent Glue Stick, apply glue to the wrong side of the craft paper, especially around the edges. Attach the paper to the front of the gift bag, lining up the edges of the paper with the bottom edge of the bag.
5. Cut a piece of the black craft paper  $\frac{1}{4}$  the length and the full width of the front of the bag.
6. Using the Scotch® Permanent Glue Stick, apply glue to the wrong side of the craft paper especially around the edges. Attach the paper to the front of the bag, lining up the edge of the black craft paper with the top edge of the bag so it meets the spiderweb craft paper.



7. Cut a piece of the black satin ribbon the entire width of the front of the bag.
8. Using the precision tip of Scotch® Clear Glue, attach the ribbon to the front of the gift bag so it is centered over the edges of the craft paper. Small amounts of glue can be added to the cut edges of each side of the ribbon to prevent fraying.



9. Attach the letters of the child's name centered on the black craft paper.



10. Using the Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue, attach the spider onto the center of the spiderweb placing it at a slight angle.
11. Fill the bag with treats and fold the flap under 1/2 inch and secure with Scotch® Double Sided Tape to close the bag.
