

How to Use Scotch® Clear Glue Stick for Cardmaking

Butterfly Song



Artistic floral scrapbooking paper offers a warm home for a fluttering butterfly. **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick** is used to attach coordinating paper on both the inside and outside of a plain card and also to attach the butterfly's shadow.



Difficulty – Medium

Materials

- Plain white gift card (plain gift cards can be found at your local craft store)
- Orange and purple flower patterned scrapbooking paper
- Purple cardstock scrapbooking paper
- 1 sheet cream colored stationary paper
- 1 colorful butterfly
- Assorted mini rhinestones to match the color of the butterfly and paper
- **Scotch® 6-inch Precision Scissors** (for cutting paper and ribbon)
- **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick** (for attaching scrapbooking paper)
- **Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue** (for gluing rhinestones)
- **Scotch® Removable Double-Sided Tape** (for attaching stationary paper)
- **Scotch® Foam Mounting Tape** (for attaching butterfly)

Instructions

1. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of the flower patterned scrapbooking paper the entire length and width of the front of the card.
2. Using the **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick**, apply glue to the wrong side of the flower patterned paper, especially around the edges. Attach it to the front of the gift card, lining up the edges of the paper with the edges of the card.



3. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of both the flower patterned scrapbooking paper the size of the inside left of the card and the purple cardstock the size of the inside right of the card.



4. Using the **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick**, apply glue to the wrong side of the flower patterned scrapbooking paper, especially around the edges and attach it the inside left of the card. Apply glue the wrong side of the purple cardstock and attach it to the inside right of the card.



5. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of the stationary paper two inches smaller than the length and one inch smaller than the width of the inside right of the card.
6. Using **Scotch® Removable Double-Sided Tape**, apply strips of tape to the wrong side of the top, bottom and sides of the stationary paper.
7. Attach the piece of stationary to the inside right of the card, centering it evenly between the top and sides.

Note: The removable double-sided tape allows for easy repositioning without damaging the paper.



- Trace an outline of the butterfly about 1/4 inch larger than the actual butterfly onto the purple cardstock and cut it out using **Scotch® Precision Scissors**.



- Using the **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick**, apply glue to the wrong side of the butterfly shape, especially around the edges. Attach it to the upper right corner of the card at a slight angle.



10. Using **Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue**, apply dots of glue onto the inside of the flowers and attach rhinestones to add sparkle to the card.



11. Cut a piece of the **Scotch® Foam Mounting Tape** and apply it to the back of the butterfly. Attach the butterfly centered on top of the purple butterfly shape to create its shadow.
