

How to Use Scotch® 6-Inch Precision Scissors for Cardmaking

FRESH
CUT



This card design uses **Scotch® 6-inch Precision Scissors** to create the detailed cutting around the flowers. Contrasting paper is used on the inside of the card so it shows through the die-cut edge.



Difficulty – Medium

Materials

- Plain white gift card (plain gift cards can be found at your local craft store)
- Floral patterned scrapbooking paper with white space
- Pink cardstock scrapbooking paper
- 1/4 inch wide green ribbon
- Opal glitter glue
- **Scotch® 6-inch Precision Scissors** (for cutting paper and ribbon)
- **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick** (for attaching scrapbooking paper)
- **Scotch® Removable Double-Sided Tape** (for attaching inside paper)
- **Scotch® Clear Glue with 2-Way Applicator** (for attaching ribbon)

Instructions

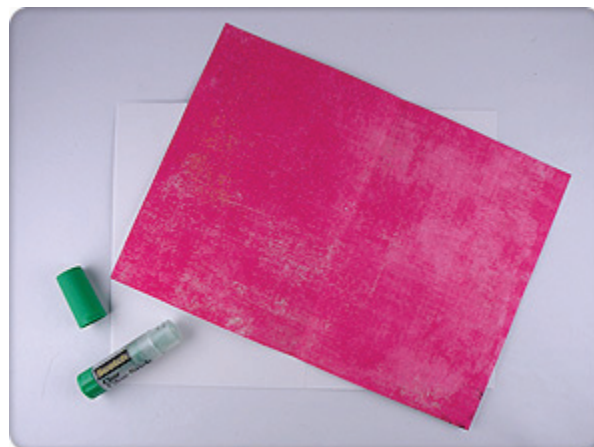
1. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of the flower patterned scrapbooking paper the entire length and width of the front of the card.



2. Using the **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick**, apply glue to the wrong side of the flower patterned paper, especially around the edges. Attach it to the front of the gift card, lining up the edges of the paper with the edges of the card.



3. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of the pink contrast paper the entire length and width of the inside spread of the card.
4. Using the **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick**, apply glue to the wrong side of the contrast paper, especially around the edges and attach it the inside the card.



5. Lightly trace the outline of the die cut around the pattern of the flowers in an interesting pattern.
6. Using **Scotch® 6-inch Precision Scissors**, cut closely along the outline of the flowers to reveal the contrast paper.



7. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of the floral paper one inch smaller than the length and two inches smaller than the width of the inside right of the card



8. Using **Scotch® Removable Double-Sided Tape**, apply strips of tape to the wrong side of the top, bottom and sides of the floral paper.
9. Attach the piece of paper to the inside right of the card, centering it evenly between the top and meeting it with the folded center of the card.

Note: The removable double-sided tape allows for easy repositioning without damaging the paper.



10. Cut two pieces of ribbon the length of the card.
11. Using the precision tip of **Scotch® Clear Glue**, attach the ribbon to each side ½ inch from the center fold of the inside of the card.



12. Cut two more pieces of ribbon the length of the card.
13. Using the precision tip of **Scotch® Clear Glue**, attach the ribbons to the front of the card, lined up with the left folded edge and meeting the edges of the ribbon together.
14. Apply the opal glitter glue to the petals of the small flowers on the front of the card to add shimmer to the design.
