

# Gift Card

## Gift Card

This design incorporates the gift wrapping and card all in one. The card creates a decorative center piece for the gift wrap and can easily be removed as a keepsake. These gifts can be adjusted for any occasion by changing the colors and embellishment.



## Gift Bag



Difficulty – Easy

### Materials

- White gift bag with stiff handles (plain gift bags are inexpensive and easy to find at your local craft or party store)
- White plain gift card (plain gift cards can be found at your local craft store)
- Blue polka dot scrapbooking paper
- Blue striped scrapbooking paper
- Blue cardstock
- 1/2 inch wide blue satin ribbon
- 1 blue baby stroller party favor
- Blue decorative tissue
- **Scotch® Precision Scissors** (for cutting paper and ribbon)
- **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick** (for attaching scrapbooking paper)
- **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** (for ribbon and baby stroller)
- **Scotch® Removable Double Sided Tape** (for attaching card)

### Instructions

1. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of the blue scrapbooking paper 1 inch larger than the entire length and width of the front of the card.
2. Using the **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick**, apply glue to the wrong side of the blue scrapbooking paper, especially around the edges. Attach it to the front of the bag centered between the top, bottom and side edges of the bag.



3. To cover the handles, apply a small amount of **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** to a few inches of the back of the blue ribbon and wrap the ribbon around the handle where it meets with the inside of the bag.
4. Continue to add small amounts of glue to the ribbon a few inches at a time, slightly overlapping the ribbon as you continue to wrap the ribbon around the handle.
5. Finish by cutting the ribbon and gluing the end behind the handle where it meets with the inside of the bag. Repeat this process with the other handle.



6. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors**, cut a piece of the blue striped scrapbooking paper 2/3 the length and the full width of the front of the card.

7. Using the **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick**, apply glue to the wrong side of the striped paper, especially around the edges. Attach it to the front of the gift card, lining up the bottom edge of the paper with the bottom edge of the card.
8. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors**, cut a piece of the blue polka dot scrapbooking paper 1/3 the length and the full width of the front of the card.
9. Using the **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick**, apply glue to the wrong side of the polka dot paper, especially around the edges. Attach it to the front of the card, lining up the top edge of the paper with the top edge of the card.



10. Cut a piece of the blue ribbon the entire width of the front of the card plus two inches
11. Using a small amount of **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive**, attach the piece of ribbon to the card overlapping the edges of the scrapbooking paper. Fold the extra 2 inches in to form a loop on the right side of the card as shown below. Glue the end under the ribbon strip so the edge of the ribbon is not exposed.
12. Using **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive**, apply glue to the back of the baby stroller and attach it to the center of the blue polka dot section of the card.



13. Cut a very small piece of **Scotch® Reclosable Fastener** and attach it to the each side of the inside of the card so the card can be sealed yet opened with the ribbon tab.
14. Apply long strips of **Scotch® Removable Double Sided Tape** to the back side of the card and attach it to the center front of the blue scrapbooking paper so the card can be easily be removed and saved.
15. Fill the bag with layered tissue paper.



## Wrapped Box

This design can be adapted to almost any size or shape box.



Difficulty – Medium

### Materials

- Multicolored polka dot wrapping paper
- Double-sided pink scrapbooking paper (cardstock weight)
- 1/2 inch wide pink grosgrain ribbon
- 1 small decorative bear party favor
- 1 pink rhinestone
- **Scotch® Paper Cutter** (for cutting wrapping paper)
- **Scotch® Double Sided Tape or Scotch® Pop-Up Tape** (for wrapping gift)
- **Scotch® Precision Scissors** (for cutting paper and ribbon)
- **Scotch® Removable Double Sided Tape** (for attaching card)
- **Scotch® Reclosable Fasteners** (for closing card)
- **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** (for gluing ribbon, bear and rhinestone)

### Instructions

1. Wrap a box in polka dot wrapping paper using either **Scotch® Double Sided Tape** or **Scotch® Pop-Up Tape**.
2. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of ribbon the length to wrap around the entire wrapped box plus one inch.
3. Wrap the ribbon around the length of the box and apply a small amount of **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** to each end of the ribbon, attaching the ends to the bottom of the box.



4. Cut a piece of the pink scrapbooking paper 5 inches long by 11 inches wide.
5. Measure the center point on each short end of the card. Mark 3 inches from both short ends of the card on both the top and bottom edges. Lightly draw lines from the center point on the ends to each of the 3 inch marks. Draw a rounded edge on each of the points and cut using **Scotch® Precision Scissors**.



6. Fold in 3 inches on each side of the card so the flaps slightly overlap.



7. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of ribbon the length to wrap around the entire front of the card.
8. Apply a small amount of **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** to the back of the ribbon and attach to the front of the card, matching the ribbon on both sides of the card flaps.



9. To make the bow, cut four 6 inch pieces of pink ribbon. Fold the ends to middle, overlapping about 1/4 inch, and glue with **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** to form a loop.





10. Apply glue to the inside center to create two loops.



11. Using **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive**, attach the two of the ribbon loops onto the center of the top flap of card to form a plus shape.

12. Attach the remaining two ribbon loops to the center of the top flap of the card at an angle to form an X shape.

13. Using **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive**, attach the rhinestone to the center of the bear and apply glue to the back of the bear and attach to the center of the ribbon bow.



14. Cut a small piece of **Scotch® Reclosable Fastener** and attach it to the inside of the card flap so it meets with the overlapped portion of the inside card flap.
15. Apply long strips of **Scotch® Removable Double Sided Tape** to the back side of the card and attach it to the center front of the box so the card can be easily removed and saved.
