

How to Use Scotch® Purple Glue Stick for Crafts

Living Doll



Create a one of a kind paper doll from a photo of your child. She will love to dress up a tiny version of herself with clothes made using **Scotch® Purple Glue Stick**.



Difficulty – Medium

Materials

- A 6 inch photo of your child
- White cardstock
- Plain white printer paper
- Assorted colors and patterns of fabric and paper for making clothes
- Assorted beads, rhinestones and ribbon for accessorizing clothes
- **Scotch® Purple Glue Stick** (for attaching photo and fabric to cardstock)
- **Scotch® 6-in Precision Scissors** (for cutting out doll and clothes)
- **Scotch® Clear Glue with 2-Way Applicator** (for attaching ribbon)
- **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** (for gluing beads and rhinestones)
- **Scotch™ Self-Sealing Laminating Pouches 8.5"x11"** (for laminating photo doll)
- **Scotch® Removable Double-Stick Tape Removable** (for attaching clothes to the doll)

Instructions

1. Print out a 6 inch photo of your child. Try to take a picture of her in a paper doll stance. Apply **Scotch® Purple Glue Stick**, to the wrong side of the photo and attach it to the cardstock.



2. Using **Scotch® 6-inch Precision Scissors**, cut out the shape of your child leaving about a 1/4 inch space around your child. The 6-inch precision scissors make it easy to maneuver around tight corners.



3. Following the instructions on the package, laminate the cutout of your child with **Scotch™ Self-Sealing Laminating Pouches**.



4. Using **Scotch® 6-inch Precision Scissors**, cut the laminating pouch around the cardstock shape of your child leaving about a 1/4 inch space so laminating seal stays intact.



5. Place a sheet of white printer paper on top of the laminated doll and trace the outline of a dress so it matches the shape of your child.
6. Cut out the dress shape with **Scotch® 6-inch Precision Scissors**.



- Using the dress cutout as a template trace the shape onto a piece of white cardstock and fabric of your choice. Cutout the shapes with **Scotch® 6-inch Precision Scissors** and attach the fabric to the cardstock with **Scotch® Purple Glue Stick**.
- Continue to make clothes templates of different styles following the same process.



- Use **Scotch® Clear Glue with 2-Way Applicator** to attach ribbon accents and **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** to attach beads and rhinestones to the clothes.
- Use your imagination and scraps of paper or fabric you have on hand to make an exciting wardrobe for your doll.



11. Apply a piece of **Scotch® Removable Double-Stick Tape** to front of the doll to attach the clothes.
