

How to Use Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive for Crafts

Flower Garden



An unfinished wood picture frame can be easily decorated to match a photo's theme. Flower and butterfly buttons are attached to this design using **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** making the frame into a little flower garden.



Difficulty – Easy

Materials

- Unfinished wood picture frame
- White wood paint
- 6 flower buttons without shank in different colors
- 2 butterfly buttons without shank
- 1/8 inch-wide green satin ribbon
- **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** (for gluing buttons)
- **Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Precision Scissors** (for cutting ribbon)
- **Scotch® Scotch® Clear Glue with 2-Way Applicator** (for attaching ribbon)

Instructions

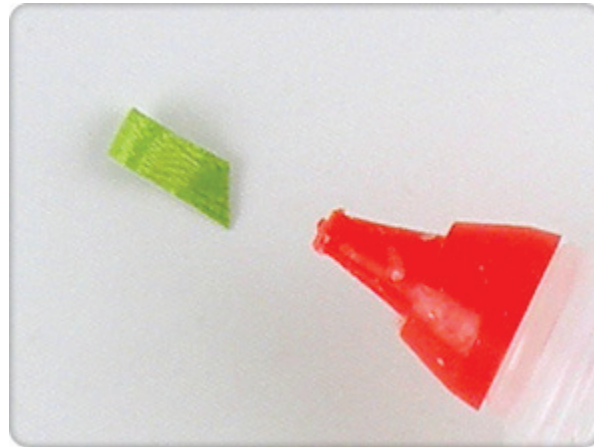
1. Paint the frame with white paint and let dry.
2. Using **Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Precision Scissors**, cut three 1-1/4 inch pieces of ribbon and three 3/4 inch pieces for the stems.



3. Using **Scotch® Clear Glue**, attach the ribbon stems to the bottom of the frame, alternating between short and long, leaving an equal distance between each stem.



4. Using the **Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Precision Scissors**, cut nine 3/4 inch pieces of ribbon.
5. Using the precision tip, apply a small amount of **Scotch® Clear Glue** to the end of each of the ribbons. Fold the pieces of ribbon in half and attach the ends together. Let dry.
6. Cut the end of each ribbon at a slight angle.



7. Using precision tip of **Scotch® Clear Glue**, apply a dot of glue to the stems and attach the leaves in the configuration shown below. Tweezers can be used to hold the leaves so they are easier to handle.



8. Apply **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** to the wrong side of each of the flower buttons and attach them to the top of the stems.
9. Glue the butterfly buttons to the side of the frame to make them appear to be fluttering around the flowers.



10. Insert your favorite picture into the frame that matches your theme.
