

## How to Use Scotch® Mega Glue Stick for Cardmaking

### Silk Kimono



Coordinating themes and colors of scrapbooking paper are grafted together using **Scotch® Mega Glue Stick**. Two main colors are chosen from the card to accent the flowers with silk ribbon and beads making this an elegant design.



Difficulty – Medium

## Materials

- White card stock folded in half and trimmed to make a 5-1/2 inch x 8 inch card
- 1 sheet each of coordinating themes and colors of scrapbooking paper (one with big flowers)
- 1/4-inch wide blue satin ribbon
- 1/4-inch wide rose satin ribbon
- 1 bag of small blue seed beads
- **Scotch® Mega Glue Stick** (for attaching scrapbooking paper)
- **Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Scissors** (for cutting paper and ribbon)
- **Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue** (for gluing beads)

## Instructions

1. Using **Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Scissors** cut one of the sheets of the floral scrapbooking paper 8 inches x 4-1/4 inches. Cut the coordinating piece of paper 8 inches x 1-1/4 inches.
2. Using the **Scotch® Mega Glue Stick**, apply glue to the wrong side of the floral paper, especially around the edges. Attach the pieces of scrapbooking paper to front of the gift card, lining up the edges of the paper with the edges of the card and meeting the two pieces together on the left side of the card.



3. Using **Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Scissors**, cut nine 1-1/2 inch pieces of rose silk ribbon. Fold the ends to middle, overlapping about 1/8 inch and glue together using **Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue** to form a loop.
4. Apply glue to the inside center to create two loops.



5. Using the **Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue**, glue the three of the ribbon loops together, one at a time onto the center of each other to form a flower.



6. Fill in the center of the flower with **Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue**. Sprinkle beads onto the glue so all of the spaces are filled in. Some adjusting may need to be done to the center of the flower by adding dots of glue and adding more beads.



7. Using **Scotch® Ultra-Edge Non-Stick Scissors** cut a piece of the blue satin ribbon the entire length of the front of the card.
8. Using the precision tip of **Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue**, attach the ribbon to the front of the card over the seams of the two papers. Small amounts of glue can be added to the cut edges of each end of the ribbon to prevent fraying.



9. Using the **Scotch® Quick Drying Tacky Glue**, apply glue to the wrong side of each of the flower and attach two in the center of the two flowers and one on the ribbon divider.
